<u>"YOU HAVE BEEN "CALLED"</u> to become one of us. We work at supporting and promoting vocations to the Priesthood, Diaconate and Religious life. We think God sees our effort as one aspect of honoring HIS love.

How much does religion cost?

In the book "Personal Vocation: God calls everyone by name" by Germain Grisez and Russell Shaw, the authors, talk about everyone's vocation. "God acts first. A personal vocation comes from Him and is His plan for a person's unique cooperation with Him. But God also gives us the grace to make free commitments to this calling and to live the lives of good deeds He intends. Here is a covenant of love and fidelity between a human person and God, fulfilled on the human side by living out of a personal vocation and on God's side by the final perfecting of the individual with all the blessings of eternal life. That's how much it costs!"

WHY ARE WE HERE?

An elderly parishioner approached her priest after a Sunday service and said "Father, thanks so much for your words. I often pray to God and ask why I am here as you suggested. Why, not a day goes by that I'll walk downstairs at my home and when I get there I find myself saying; Oh God, why am I here?"

In December the Board of Directors approved the "One Hundred Club" as an ongoing source of supplemental funds to the regular bi-annual dues paid by Serra Club members. The purpose is to provide funds to implement or initiate programs which will publicize our goals throughout the many parishes of the Deanery. The "one hundred" refers to the request for a one hundred dollar annual donation.

Operating effectively takes people. We need more to join us and help. Some fifty members now hold St. Charles Serra Club cards. We need one hundred fifty to cover the many parishes and the geographic area of the deanery. A substantial amount of our dues go to support the National Organization. We therefore must find ways to fund our printing supplies, mailing costs, and the large number of copies required to distribute information throughout the Deanery.

All Serrans are urged to distribute the One Hundred Club Applications and solicit new members who they believe will support vocations. Every Serran is also asked to consider membership in this club.

Requests for the membership brochures have already been mailed to all members and to all parishes. Each parish has been asked to take a membership. Many have already signed on to support Deanery Vocation programs. The Serra Club belongs to the laity in the Deanery. It will succeed or fail according to the support provided by the laity.

As the priest told the elderly parishioner, pray often to God and ask Him why you are here. But don't be forgetful. Remember **HE** is the answer!
